

Course Rooms at Ref. KGH Höngg

Directions

Preliminary Remark

Tanzclub Academia rents rooms for courses from the Zurich-Höngg parish. Due to the existing prioritisation system, it is possible that the preferred course room may not be available on some dates. For this reason, this sheet contains directions to all possible course rooms for courses taking place at KGH Höngg.

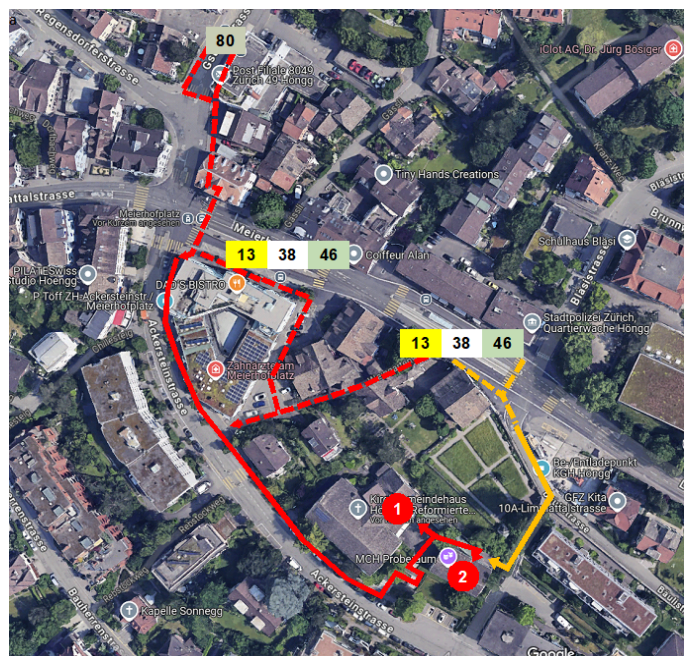
Rooms at Kirchgemeindehaus (KGH): Saal, Zwingli-Saal

Directions to Kirchgemeindehaus

The Ref. Kirchgemeindehaus (Ackersteinstrasse 190, 8049 Zurich; no. 1 on the map on the right) is just a few minutes' walk from "Meierhofplatz" stop (tram 13; bus 38, 46, 80).

From the Meierhofplatz junction, follow Ackersteinstrasse past the KGH and walk up the wide staircase (red path on the map on the right). Entrance at the end of the glass front on the left (roofed).

Alternatively, walk from Limmattalstrasse into Bäulistrasse, turn right into the footpath after approx. 50 metres and follow this, including around the sharp right turn after approx. 30 metres (orange path on the map on the right). Follow the roofed walkway; the entrance is at its end.



Cloakroom

The cloakroom is located directly at the entrance to the KGH on the right-hand side. We kindly ask – in consideration of the wooden floor and other people's shoes – that umbrellas, moist clothing as well as heavy and/or wet shoes are deposited in the cloakroom, especially in wet weather.

Saal (incl. "Saal vorne" and "Saal hinten")

The "Saal" is located opposite the cloakroom, ¼ turn to left from the entrance. The entrance to "Saal hinten" is on the left (under the A), the entrance to "Saal vorne" is on the right (under the Q).

Zwingli-Saal

Standing with your back to the cloakroom (i.e. facing "Saal"), the entrance to Zwingli-Saal is on the right-hand side, halfway between the cloakrooms and the "Saal".

WCs

Located in the basement. From the entrance door, walk straight ahead, slightly to the left, past the cloakroom towards the kitchen. Directly in front of the kitchen is the staircase on the left and the lift on the right.

Rooms at Schulhaus: Bullinger-Zimmer, Leo-Jud-Zimmer

Directions to Schulhaus

The parish school building (“Schulhaus”, Ackersteinstrasse 186, 8049 Zurich; no. 2 on the map above) is just a few minutes’ walk from the “Meierhofplatz” stop (tram 13; bus 38, 46, 80).

Basically the same as to the Kirchgemeindehaus, but at the end of the stairs turn right instead of left (red path) or take the entrance to the building on the left at the beginning of the roofed corridor (orange path).

Cloakroom

It is possible to leave jackets, shoes and bags in the entrance area of the school building. We kindly ask – in consideration of other people’s shoes – that umbrellas, moist clothing as well as heavy and/or wet shoes are deposited in the cloakroom, especially in wet weather.

Bullinger-Zimmer

First door on the right-hand side on the ground floor.

Leo-Jud-Zimmer

First door on the left-hand side on the ground floor.

WCs

In the basement: From the entrance door, go straight ahead to the other end of the corridor, ½ turn to left, down the stairs, ½ turn to left, to the door at the end of the corridor.

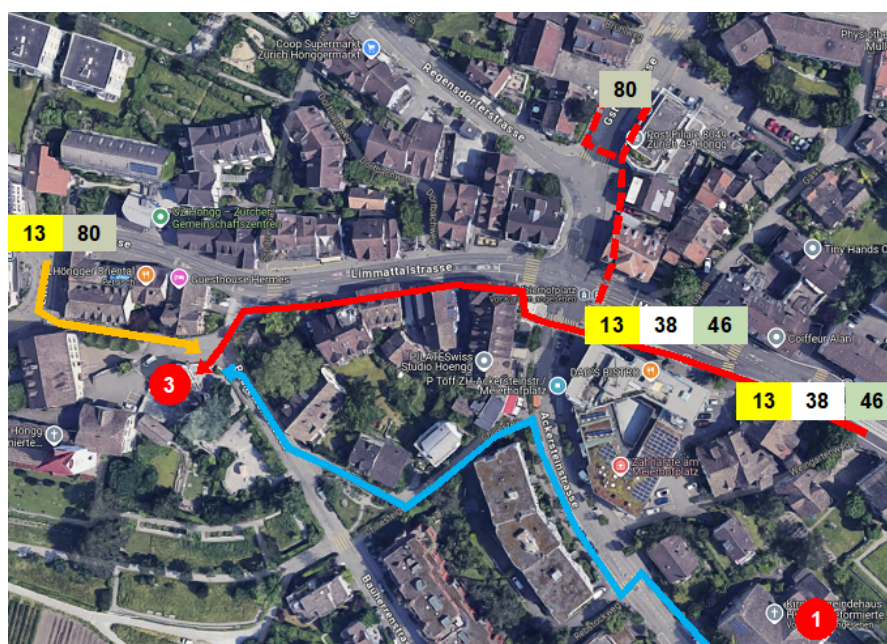
Room at Haus Sonnegg: Sonnegg-Saal

Directions to Haus Sonnegg

Haus Sonnegg (Bauherrenstrasse 53, 8049 Zurich, no. 3 on the map on the right) is just a few minutes’ walk from “Meierhofplatz” (tram 13; bus 38, 46, 80) and “Zwielplatz” (tram 13; bus 80) stop.

From Meierhofplatz, follow Limmatalstrasse out of town for approx. 100 metres, then turn left into Bauherrenstrasse (red path on the map on the right). Haus Sonnegg is straight ahead / slightly to the right, the garden gate is generally open.

From “Zwielplatz” stop, walk onto Zwielplatz and turn left at the end onto “Am Wettingertobel”. After approx. 50 metres you will find Haus Sonnegg on the right-hand side (orange path).



From the KGH (no. 1 on the map above), follow Ackersteinstrasse uphill towards Meierhofplatz, crossing the road behind the KGH. Before the Pizzeria Rapido, turn left onto “Chillesteig”, keep right after approx. 50 metres and follow “Chorherrenweg”. At the end of the path, cross the road and follow it to the right. Haus Sonnegg is about 40 metres further along on the left-hand side (blue path).

If the door to the building is locked: Please ring the bell “Saal” and be patient, someone will come to open the door (finish instructing the group, take the key and go down one floor, this may take one to two minutes).

Cloakroom

There are two cloakrooms in Haus Sonnegg: One at the entrance and one in front of the Saal, both rather small.

As the flooring from the staircase onwards is made of wood and in consideration of other people’s shoes, we kindly ask that umbrellas, moist clothing as well as heavy and/or wet shoes are deposited in the cloakroom on the ground floor (to the right of the entrance door).

Sonnegg-Saal

The Sonnegg-Saal is located on the first floor, accessible via the lift on the left or the staircase on the right. From the lift turn $2 \times \frac{1}{4}$ to the left, from the stairs first turn $\frac{1}{4}$ to the right, then turn $\frac{1}{4}$ to the right again before the lift, then $\frac{1}{4}$ to the left.

WCs

In the basement, either via the stairs (directly at the end of the stairs $\frac{1}{4}$ turn to left, then straight ahead for ladies and another $\frac{1}{4}$ turn to left for men) or via the lift ($\frac{1}{4}$ turn to right for ladies, straight ahead for men).
